
NOTES:

- 1. Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove debris.
- 2. If possible, install this faucet before installing the lavatory.
- 3. Inspect the supply tubing for damage and leakage. Replace and maintain as necessary.
- 4. Observe local plumbing codes.
- 5. Shut off the water supplies to the fitting.

HANDLE OPERATION

Lift the handle gently. Turn clockwise for cold water, turn counter-colckwise for hot water.






Faucet - Side Lever Mount bry Faucet - Side Lever Mount Lavatory Faucet - Side Lever Mount


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

How to Install the Spout

If needed to take off the hoses(1) to repair, reinstall and tighten them by hand.

Insert lift rod(2) into the hole at the rear of the body(3). Install the washer(4) into the groove at the bottom of the escutcheon(5). Slide the escutcheon and washer over the hoses(1) and shank(6).


Insert the faucet assembly into the lavatory hole.

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Position the faucet, install the screws(10) into the mounting nut(9). From underside of the lavatory, place the washers(7, 8) onto the shank. Tighten the mounting nut to secure the faucet. Tighten the screw.

Attach the hoses to water supplies. The hose with "COLD" label connects to cold water.

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How to Install the Drain

Remove stopper(11), flange(17), washer(18) and tailpiece(16) from drain body(13). Supply enough tape or sealant to tailpiece thread. Reinstall the tailpiece. Insert drain body kit into the lavatory from underside, and make sure the drain lever hole(14) facing to the back of the lavatory. Screw the flange with washer into the drain body. Tighten the locknut(15) by hand from the underside of the fixture.


NOTE: If needed, apply a ring of plumbers putty around the underside of the drain flange(17), instead of using washer(18).


Place stopper(11) into drain body aligning the flat side of stopper hole(12) with the drain lever hole.


Remove the latch(19) and retaining nut(20). Fit the plastic washer(21) and retaining nut onto the ball lever(22). Insert the ball lever assembly into the drain lever hole and through the stopper hole. Tighten the retaining nut.

Be sure that the ball lever(22) points to the back of the lavatory, tighten the locknut(15) on the drain body by wrench.

NOTE: Do not reposition the drain if plumbers putty applied after the locknut is tightened, or you may break the putty seal. Wipe away excess plumbers putty.







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	Way 2: Select the link kit(25, 26 & 27).
<i>2</i> 7	According to the lift rod length, bend the link(25).
25	Connect the link onto ball lever rod with "V" clip(26). Slide lift rod(2) into the hole on link.
×22	Push the ball lever rod(22) down to the open position. Tighten thumb screw(27).
