
NOTES

- 1. Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove debris.
- 2. Inspect the supply tubing for damage and leakage. Replace and maintain as necessary.
- 3. Observe local plumbing codes.
- 4. Check for leaks before cover the pipes, repairs as needed.
- 5. Please ensure only apply water pressure test on the product, and empty the air in pipe and faucet thoroughly before the test. Please ensure test pressure below 0.8MPa (8 bar) and test duration within 30 minutes.


HANDLE OPERATION

For 73081T-3, turn on the left handle clockwise for hot water, turn on the right handle counter-clockwise for cold water. For 73081T-4, turn on the left handle counter-clockwise for hot water, turn on the right handle clockwise for cold water.


ROUGH-IN DIMENSIONS

How to Install the Yoke

Do not take off guards(1) at this moment.

Connect the G1/2" water supply pipes(2) to the supply yoke(3).


The finished wall must be between the mark Max and Min line on the guard. Make sure the left supply pipe is the hot supply and connected to the end with red mark.

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


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

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How to Install the Spout


Remove and discard the spout guards after completed the finished wall.

Insert the washer(9) into the groove of the escutcheon base(8).

Install the escutcheon base onto the connector(10) until against the finished wall. **NOTE:** Don't damage the O-ring(11) on connector.

Loosen the screws(15) in the spout kit(14) with 2mm hex wrench(13).

Install the spout kit to the connector with the spout outlet downward. Tighten the screw to secure the spout kit.



How to Install the Drain


Remove the locknut(18), plastic washer(20) and the rubber gasket(19) and tailpiece(15) from the drain body. Supply enough tape or sealant to tailpiece thread. Reinstall the tailpiece.

Insert the drain body into the lavatory. Install the rubber gasket(Tapered side up), plastic washer and locknut back to the drain body in turn. Tighten the locknut.

NOTE: If needed, apply a ring of plumbers putty or other sealants around the underside of the drain flange(16), instead of using rubber washer(17).

Do not reposition the drain after the locknut is tightened, or you may break the putty or sealant seal. Remove any excess putty.

INSTALLATION CHECKOUT




Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the off position.

Open the drain. Turn on main water supply and check for leaks. Repair as required.

Remove aerator(21) by key(22). Turn the faucet handle on and run hot and cold water through spout for about one minute to remove any debris.

Remove any debris from aerator. Shut faucet off and reinstall aerator.



Replacing the Washer and Piston Kit

Turn counter clockwise to remove the stopper(24). Take out washer(25). Replace with a new one.

Turn counter clockwise to remove the piston kit(23). Replace with a new one. Reinstall stopper and washer.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

All Finishes: Clean the finish with mild soap and warm water. Wipe entire surface completely dry with clean soft cloth. Many cleaners may contain chemicals, such as ammonia, chlorine, toilet cleaner etc, which could adversely affect the finish and are not recommended for cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on Kohler faucets and fittings.
