
### NOTES:

- 1. Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove debris.
- 2. Inspect the supply tubing for damage and leakage. Replace and maintain as necessary.
- 3. Observe local plumbing codes.
- 4. If possible, install the faucet before installing the tub.

5. The highest working pressure for handshower is 0.5MPa(5bar). If it exceeds 0.5MPa(5bar), a pressure reducer is needed. The highest water and environment temperature is 60°C. Please keep handshower, showerhead and shower arm away from heater, or it may become damaged and cause injury to the user.



Slide the o-ring(17) into the bottom groove of the escutcheon(16). Tighten the escutcheon with the o-ring onto the diverter kit(15), and keep it against the bath tub. Position the diverter kit so that the nut(20) is on the right. Screw the nut(18). Tighten the screws(19) to secure the diverter kit.

Install the spout kit(14) onto the escutcheon. Position the spout kit so that the spout points to the front. Tighten the screw(13) with the hex wrench(12), and install the plug(11).



Install the connector(10) to the diverter kit.

Tighten the screws(9) with the hex wrench(8).

Install the lift knob(21) onto the connector(10), tighten the screws(23) with the hex wrench(22).

Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the off position.
Open the drain. Turn on the main supply and check for leaks. Repair as needed.
Remove the aerator(38) by key(39), Remove handshower(31). Open valve and run water through the spout to remove any debris. Switch to handshower to remove any debris.
Turn the valve off. Reinstall the aerator and handshower.

All Finishes: Clean the finish with mild soap and warm water. Wipe entire surface completely dry with clean soft cloth. Many cleaners may contain chemicals, such as ammonia, chlorine, toilet cleaner etc, which could
