

2. If possible, install this faucet before installing the lavatory.
3. Inspect the supply tubing for damage and leakage. Replace and maintain as necessary.
4. Observe local plumbing codes.
5. Shut off the water supplies to the fitting.


HANDLE OPERATION

Lift handle gently. Turn clockwise for hot water, turn counter-clockwise for cold water.




INSTALLATION

How to Install the Spout

Install the mounting stud(4) onto the faucet body base(1), and put the washer(3) into the groove at the bottom of the escutcheon(2). Slide the escutcheon with the washer over the flexible hoses(6) and cable end(5, only for 25102T-4).

Insert the faucet assembly into the lavatory hole. Position the faucet. From underside of the lavatory, place the brackets(7, Rubber washer is on the top) onto the mounting stud, and tighten the nut(8) with a wrench(9) to secure the faucet.

Attach the hoses to water supplies. When facing front of the faucet, the left hose connects to hot water, the right hose with "COLD" label connects to cold water.





How to Install the Drain(Only for 25102T-4)

Remove stopper(10), flange(11) and washer(12) from drain body(16). Take off the tailpiece(17). Apply thread tape to tailpiece and install the tailpiece to drain body. Insert drain body kit into the lavatory from underside, and make sure the magnetic snap(14) in the drain facing to the back of the lavatory.

Screw the flange(11) with washer into the drain body. Be sure that the magnetic snap points to the back of the lavatory, tighten the locknut(15) on the drain body by wrench. Screw the stopper(10) on the piston kit(13).

NOTE: If needed, apply a ring of plumbers putty around the underside of the drain flange(11), instead of using washer(12).



Install the cable end(5) into the magnetic snap(14), ensure the buckle is locked.

NOTE: Do not reposition the drain if plumbers putty applied after the locknut is tightened, or you may break the putty seal. Wipe away excess plumbers putty.


How to Install the Drain(Only for 25103T-4 & 25104T-4)

Remove the locknut(23), plastic washer(22), rubber gasket(21) and tailpiece(19) from the drain body. Supply enough tape or sealant to tailpiece thread. Reinstall the tailpiece.

Insert the drain body into the lavatory. Put the rubber gasket (Tapered side up), plastic washer and locknut back to the drain body in turn. Tighten the locknut.

NOTE: Do not reposition the drain after the locknut is tightened, or you may break the putty or sealant seal.


NOTE: If needed, apply a ring of plumbers putty or other sealants around the underside of the drain flange(18), instead of using rubber washer(20).



INSTALLATION CHECKOUT

Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the off position. Turn on the drain and main water supply, and check for leaks. Repair as needed.

Remove the aerator kit(24) by coin. Turn on the faucet. Run hot and cold water through the faucet for about one minute to remove any debris. Remove any debris from the aerator kit. Shut off the faucet. Reinstall the aerator kit.



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

All Finishes: Clean the finish with mild soap and warm water. Wipe entire surface completely dry with clean soft cloth. Many cleaners may contain chemicals, such as ammonia, chlorine, toilet cleaner etc, which could adversely affect the finish and are not recommended for cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on Kohler faucets and fittings.
