

3. The highest working pressure for handspray & shower head is 0.5MPa(5bar). If it exceeds 0.5MPa(5bar), a pressure reducer is needed. The highest water and environment temperature is 60°C. Please keep handspray, shower head and the shower arm away from heater, or it may become damaged and cause injury to the user.





INSTALLATION CHECKOUT

Ensure that all coupling nuts are tight. Ensure that the lever handle is in the off position. Turn on the main water supply and drain, and check for leaks. Repair as needed.

Remove the hand spray(11), filter washer(10) and aerator(12). Run hot and cold water about one minute to remove any debris. Remove any debris from the filter washer and the aerator. Shut off the faucet. Reinstall the filter washer, aerator and hand spray.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

All Finishes: Clean the finish with mild soap and warm water. Wipe entire surface completely dry with clean soft cloth. Many cleaners may contain chemicals, such as ammonia, chlorine, toilet cleaner etc, which could adversely affect the finish and are not recommended for cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on Kohler faucets and fittings.
