

# Introduction

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Thank you for purchasing a quality Mira product. To enjoy the full potential of your new product, please take time to read this guide thoroughly, having done so, keep it handy for future reference.

## Safety Information

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1. The product must be secured to a flat, sound and solid wall surface ('solid' means constructed of brick or high density concrete block).

**Warning!** All screws and wall plugs supplied must be securely fitted to the full depth.

**Note!** The product may be fixed to other wall types, but advice must be sought from a competent builder regarding wall structure and fastening prior to fitting.

Cavities, voids, loose material, cables and pipes must be avoided when locating the fixing screws.

**Note!** Make sure that the fixings are located on an even surface and are way from irregularities e.g. grout lines.

**Note!** Do not fix the grab bar supports and tile up to them.

2. **Warning!** This product has been designed as a grab bar only and should not be used for any other purposes.
3. **Warning!** Incorrectly fitting the grab bar may result in injury to the user.
4. To ensure optimum support please decide with the user on the most appropriate position before fixing.
5. Maximum load of 95.25 kg (15 stone).
6. The grab bar is designed to be fitted horizontally or vertically.

6. Only the grab bar is designed as a load carrying support. Accessories attached, that may include a handset or shower hose will not offer the same load carrying capacity.

# Guarantee

For **domestic installations**, Mira Showers guarantee the product against any defect in materials or workmanship for a period of **one year** from the date of purchase.



# Installation


**Note!** If a clamp bracket is fitted to the grab bar then the position of the shower and shower fittings must provide a minimum gap of 25 mm between the showerhead and the spill over level of any bath, shower tray or basin and a minimum gap of 30 mm between the showerhead and the spill over level of any toilet, bidet or other appliance with a Fluid Category 5 backflow risk.



**Note!** There will be occasions when, for Fluid Category 3 installations, an outlet double checkvalve must be fitted, this will increase the required supply pressure typically by 10kPa (0.1 bar). Double check valves fitted in the inlet supply to the appliance cause a pressure build up, which affect the maximum static inlet pressure for the appliance and must not be fitted. For Fluid category 5 double check valves are not suitable.




Turn the clamp bracket lever to release and lock the clamp bracket


If required, install the clamp bracket on the end of the grab bar.

**Note!** Make sure that the clamp bracket and the end of the grab bar are in the correct orientation.

**Note!** The clamp bracket is suitable for use with most Mira hoses. Please see accessories if your hose does not fit correctly or a longer hose is required.



Measure the tube length 'A' and assemble the ends.



Mark the height of the grab bar on the wall and draw a straight level line.  
Mark the positions of the fixing holes:

$$X = \text{tube length 'A' + 67 mm}$$



**Warning!** Make sure there are no buried cables or pipes in the wall before drilling.


Drill the fixing holes to the dimensions shown using a suitable drill bit. Fit the support to the wall with the fixing bolt supplied. **DO NOT** tighten fully at this stage so that the grab bar can be levelled.


Install the grab bar over the supports.



Align the grab bar making sure that it is level.


Remove the grab bar and **fully tighten** the supports.




**Note!** Make sure that the grub screws locate correctly in the groove in the supports. If installed correctly the grub screws will be flush.

Install the grub screws and **fully tighten** to secure the grab bar in position.





Measure the tube lengths 'A' and assemble the ends.

**Note!** If using the optional clamp bracket, fit before assembling the ends. Make sure that the clamp bracket and the end of the grab bar are in the correct orientation.



Mark the height of the grab bar on the wall and draw a straight level line.

$$X = \text{tube length 'A'} + 67 \text{ mm}$$



**Warning!** Make sure there are no buried cables or pipes in the wall before drilling.




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### Cleaning


